

Anguilla Regatta 2014 Notice of Race

Organised by the Anguilla Sailing Association.

- I. RULES: The regatta will be governed by
- The Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing,
- 1.2. The current CSA rating rule, and
- 1.3. The CSA Minimum Safety Requirements except that the following boats need not comply with Requirement 2 (Lifelines):
 - a) any multihull, or
 - b) any boat originally designed without lifelines.
- 2. ADVERTISING: Boats may be required to display advertising provided by the organizing authority.
- 3. CLASSES: The regatta is open to the following classes (that may be subdivided); boats are subject to the relevant classification rules:
- 3.1. CSA: Spinnaker & Non Spinnaker
- 3.2. Classes Under Non-CSA rules:
 - a) Open Class using simplified CSA
 - b) Multihull class using St Maarten Rating System
 - c) Exhibition Class 12 Metre
 - d) Anguilla Racing Boats
- 3.3. Classes may be added or deleted at the discretion of the organizing authority, and the class allocations will be published on the results website http://regattaguru.com/anguilla

4. ENTRY:

- 4.1. Entries can be made on the entry form at http://regattaguru.com/anguilla.
- 4.2. Last-minute entries can be made on the morning of Friday, 9 May by contacting the Race Committee on VHF channel 71.
- 5. FEES: Entry fee for all boats is US\$100 plus a US \$70 deposit for bow numbers (only if required). Fees are payable at registration in US Dollars by Cash, traveller's cheque, or major credit card.

6. SCHEDULE:

- 6.1. Friday 9 May: a Race from Simpson Bay, St. Maarten to Road Bay, Anguilla with the first warning signal not before 1500.
- 6.2. Registration will be held on Friday, 9 May. 2014 at the Anguilla Sailing Association building in Sandy Ground, after racing.
- 6.3. Saturday 10 May: Three or more races in the waters around Sandy Ground.
- 6.4. Sunday 11 May: One or more races in the waters around Anguilla.
- 6.5. Prizes will be given on Sunday afternoon on the beach at Sandy Ground.
- 7. COURSES: The race courses will be on the waters around the western end of the island of Anguilla. Course descriptions and sailing instructions will be available at registration.
- 7.1. All boats on all courses MUST stay outside Anguillita Island and Blowing Rock on the west end of Anguilla.
- 8. PRIZES: Overall awards will be given for each class. For yachts, prizes will be given on Sunday, 60 minutes after the finish of the last race. For Anguilla Racing Boats, prizes will be given on Sunday at 6:00 PM. All prizes are awarded from the Main Stage.
- 9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: As a condition of entry into this regatta, the entrant accepts the sole and inescapable responsibility for the management and safety of his/her boat, and understands and agrees that neither the Race Committee, the sponsors, The Anguilla Sailing Association, its Officers or Members shall accept any responsibility for the loss of life or injury to participants or others, for the loss of, or damage to, any boat, however caused, before, during or after any race. Entering the Anguilla Regatta constitutes acceptance of all disclaimers made by the regatta organizers.
- 10.Permission to use Photographs: The entrant grants permission to use his/her photograph and/or photographs of his or her boat for advertising purposes without restriction.
