## SPECTATOR GUIDE

All race documents can be found at http://regattaguru.com/asw/minisite?series\_id=10#Documents but here's what you need to know to follow the races on land or sea....

All boats race a maximum of 2 races each day from Sunday 28th April to Friday 3rd May (but not Wednesday 1st May, which is LayDay) with no race starting before 10am each morning.

There will be 2 race areas, each with their own Committee Boat. Both will be flying a blue flag with "RC" in white.

## **Both Start Boats**

Both Race Officers will decide each day which course their boats will sail and will display the course number to the competitors on white boards on their respective Start Boats as well as announcing it on their VHF Channels. For example, on Sunday, there are 4 choices of course for Start Boat A, which will be anchored between Falmouth Harbour and English Harbour (indicated as A on the Course Maps). If the Race Officer decides to use Course 1 then the boats will begin their race by crossing the start line (between Start Boat A and an orange inflatable buoy), sailing round the mark called Willoughby, leaving it to the right; round the mark called Half Moon, leaving it to the right and back to the Start Boat A to cross the finish line.

If there is to be a 2nd race for any Classe(s), it will begin as soon as possible after all the boats in that Class have finished their 1st race.
