# regattaguru.com Standard Clauses for Notice of Race - Offshore

When this document is included in a Notice of Race (NoR), the two documents combined form the 'Notice of Race' as defined in RRS Appendix J1. The NoR may change any part of this document by stating the Standard Clause (SC) changed and the change.

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The regatta is also governed by
  - a) The regattaguru.com *Caribbean Regatta* Safety and Equipment Regulations,
  - b) For any class identified as a 'CSA' class, he *CSA Rating Rules*.
- 1.3. The Sailing Instructions may also change rules.

# 2. ADVERTIŠING

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising supplied by the organising authority.

# 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats in the classes listed.
- 3.2. Boats may enter on the regatta website.

#### 4. FEES

4.1. See Information Attachment.

#### 5. IDENTIFICATION

- 5.1. All boats shall provide their sail number or other identification at registration.
- 5.2. If bow numbers are issued by the Race Committee, a deposit as stated in the NoR will be charged, payable at registration and refunded when numbers are returned within thirty days after the regatta.

# 6. SCHEDULE of EVENTS and RACING

#### 7. CLASSES AND RATINGS

- 7.1. Each entry in a CSA class must have a current and valid CSA rating certificate.
- 7.2. The Race Committee may at their discretion arrange a single-use rating for boats unable to obtain a CSA rating.

7.3. Classes may be subdivided or combined at the discretion of the Race Committee.

# 10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1. The Protest Committee may, at its discretion, impose an alternative penalty in lieu of disqualification for any infringement, including safety requirements, with the exception of an infringement of the Racing Rules parts 1 and 2. This changes RRS 64.

#### 11. SCORING

- 11.1.One race is required to be completed to constitute a series
- 11.2.A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.

### 12. PRIZES

12.1.1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes will be awarded.

# 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

# 14. PHOTOGRAPHIC AND MEDIA RIGHTS

14.1. The entrant and all crew grant to the organisers the right to use their name and image and that of the entered boat in all media for for the purposes of editorial or advertising.
