



NOTICE OF RACE



MULTI CLASS REGATTA

Date: Saturday March 17th 2012

Place: St.Maarten Yacht Club

1. RULES:

1. The organising authority is the St.Maarten Yacht Club. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing of ISAF (2009-2012) and by the sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 The regatta will be sailed as a Category "C" event.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- .1 The regatta is open to Optimist type dinghies at the discretion of the race committee, Lasers, RS Vision and the SunFast 21's from Lagoon Sailboat Rental.
- .2 For entry information we need name of entrant, country, age if under 18, t-shirt size and class sailing in.
- .3 Interest of participation must be received before Mar 10th 2012. Conformation must be received by March 18th 2012.
- .4 Opti sailors should not be older then 15.

4. BOATS

- .1 The St. Maarten Yacht Club will provide
11 optimist , 6 Laser hulls with radial rig, 4 RS Visions and 7 SunFast 21
- 4.2 All boats will be made available on a first come bases.
- 4.3 Subject to interest in participation, boats may be borrowed from other sailing clubs. Private boats are welcome to compete.

5. CLASSES

- 5.1 If entries are sufficient to warrant more than one class, a silver and a gold class may be created.
- 5.2 Class allocation may be done by the race committee at registration and cannot be a subject of a jury hearing.

6. FEES:

- 6.1 The entry fee for the regatta is \$30US. The lunch is included in the entry fee.
- 6.2 The rental fee for the LSR boats is \$80, for RS Vision \$30, and for the Lasers and the Optimists is \$20.

7. SCHEDULE:

- 7.1 Registration and the skippers briefing will be held at the St.Maarten Yacht Club on Saturday March 17th at 8:00am.
- 7.2 Racing will not start before 9:00am.on Saturday March 17th.
- 7.3 Lunch should be at about 12:30pm
- 7.4 Afternoon racing should not start before 1:30pm.
- 7.5 The last race shall not start after 3:00pm
- 7.6 Prize giving should not be before 3:30pm
- 7.7 Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after racing is finished and boats are put away.

8. COURSES:

- 8.1 Racing will take place in the Simpson Bay Lagoon, location to be announced at the skippers briefing.
- 8.2 Courses will be made available at registration.

9. SAFETY

- 9.1 For Lasers, Optimist and RS Vision Lifejackets must be worn at all times on the water.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1 Trophies will be awarded to winners.
- 2. Additional prizes may be awarded.
